

DS4SEQ: policy for all of Queensland

The Daylight Saving for South East Queensland Party (DS4SEQ), is stunned, that despite wanting to be the Premier for all of Queensland, Ms Bligh continues to ignore the calls from the South East region to introduce Daylight Saving.

The Premier was quoted as saying that Labor has no intention of changing their position on Daylight Saving and that they do not want to impose it on regional Queensland.

DS4SEQ Party Leader, Jason Furze, said, "DS4SEQ is the only party with a Daylight Saving policy for all of Queensland, not just the minority. Daylight Saving is a geographical political issue - it is not suited to north and west Queensland, however it suits the South East region. The DS4SEQ dual time zone proposal is a compromise that would satisfy the majority of all Queenslanders"

"Our goal is to see a dual time zone introduced in Queensland, that allows South East Queensland residents to enjoy the business and lifestyle benefits of Daylight Saving, but accommodates the desire for rural and regional Queenslanders to remain without it. Unlike other parties, ours is a policy for all of Queensland", Mr Furze said.

DS4SEQ, are fielding 32 candidates in the 2009 Queensland State election. The party asks South East Queensland to vote DS4SEQ number 1, then vote 2 for whom you wish to govern Queensland. This will send a clear message to the major parties that Daylight Saving is an issue for the region and a dual time zone must be considered.

Daylight Saving for South East Queensland gives voters the unique opportunity to have their say on Daylight Saving in the South East as well as all policies that matter to them.
